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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, a natural person competent to contract and a Doctor of Medicine duly licensed to render services as such under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the Professional Service Corporation Act and other laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation is Charlotte D. Owens, M.D., P.A. The principal office and mailing address for this corporation is 10243 Emerald Woods Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32836.

ARTICLE II - GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

- A. To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of rendering the same professional services to the public that a Doctor of Medicine duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida is authorized to render, but such professional services will be rendered only through officers, employees and agents of the corporation who are duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida to practice medicine therein.
- B. It is intended that this corporation may conduct and transact any business lawfully authorized and not prohibited by Chapter 607 and Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as the same may be from time to time amended.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of capital stock that this corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is five hundred (500) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE

The initial street address of the registered office of this Corporation in the State of Florida is 10243 Emerald Woods Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32836. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the registered office to any other address in Florida. The name of the initial registered agent of this Corporation at that address is Charlotte D. Owens, M.D. The Board of Directors may from time to time designate a new registered agent.

ARTICLE V - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation will commence existence on April 15, 2002, and it will exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. The initial number of Directors of this corporation is one (1).
- B. The number of Directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by Bylaws adopted by the shareholders or Directors, but will never be less than one (1).

ARTICLE VIII - SHAREHOLDERS

Shares of this corporation's capital stock will be issued only to individuals who are duly licensed to render services as a Doctor of Medicine under the laws of the State of Florida. No shareholder of this corporation may sell or transfer her shares of stock therein except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder hereunder. No shareholder of this corporation will enter into a voting trust agreement or any other type of agreement vesting in another person the authority to exercise the voting power of any or all of his shares.

The power to adopt, amend or repeal Bylaws for the management of this corporation will be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION
