Articles of Incorporation

of

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, Chapter 607 Florida Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

EFFECTIVE DATE

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is BILL'S LOW COST TRANSMISSION & AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR, INC.

ARTICLE II. EFFECTIVE DATE & DURATION

The effective date of the incorporation shall be October 1, 2003, or as soon after that date as the Articles of Incorporation are filed in the office of the Secretary of State. The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual or until dissolved on a vote of the shareholders.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the following purposes:
