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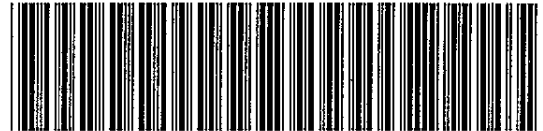

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FARM STORES OF TAMPA, INC.,
A FLORIDA CORPORATION**

The undersigned acting as Incorporator of a Florida corporation ("Corporation"), under the Florida General Corporation Act, Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby causes to be delivered the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be **Farms Stores of Tampa, Inc.**

ARTICLE II

ADDRESS

The address of the principal office of this corporation shall be 5800 Northwest 74th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33166, and the mailing address shall be the same.

ARTICLE III

COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The corporate existence shall begin on the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Department of State.

ARTICLE IV

NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage or transact in any and all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida or any other state, country, territory or nation.

ARTICLE V

CAPITAL STOCK

The Corporation is authorized to issue One Thousand (1,000) shares of Common Stock having a par value of One Cent (\$0.01) per share.

ARTICLE VI

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 5800 Northwest 74th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33166, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of the Corporation at that address is Juan Diaz, Esquire.

ARTICLE VII

TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VIII

INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall initially have two (2) directors to hold office until the first annual meeting of shareholders and his successors shall have been duly elected and qualified, or until his earlier resignation, removal from office or death. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the Bylaws of the Corporation. ARTICLE IX

INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENTS

The power to amend these Articles of Incorporation in accordance with law is reserved to the shareholders.

ARTICLE XI

INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, a director of the Corporation shall not be liable to the Corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for an act or omission in the director's capacity as a director, except that this Article X does not eliminate or limit the liability of a director of the Corporation to the extent the director is found liable for: (i) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its shareholders; (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law; (iii) under Section 607.0834 of the Florida Statutes, as the same may be amended; or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. All references in Article X to a "director" shall also be deemed to refer (x) to a member of the governing body of the Corporation which is not authorized to issue capital stock, and (y) to such other person or persons, if any, who, pursuant to a provision of the articles of incorporation in accordance with Section 607.0801 of the Florida Statutes, as the same may be amended, exercise or perform any of the powers or duties otherwise conferred or imposed upon the board of directors by this Florida

Statutes, as the same may be amended. Any repeal or amendment of this Article by the shareholders of the Corporation shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any limitation on the personal liability of a director of the Corporation arising from an act or omission occurring prior to the time of such repeal or amendment. In addition to the circumstances in which a director of the Corporation is not personally liable as set forth in the foregoing provisions of this Article X, a director shall not be liable to the Corporation or its shareholders to such further extent as permitted by any law hereafter enacted, including without limitation any subsequent amendment to the Florida Statutes.



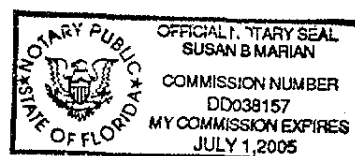
