OF DECLARATION AND CHARTER

GENERAL SECURITY PROPERTY AND CASUALTY COMPANY UNDER

SECTION 1206 OF THE INSURANCE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND

SECTION 805 OF THE NEW YORK BUSINESS CORPORATION LAW

We, the undersigned Dale S. Hammond and Edwin P. Schultz of General Security Property and Casualty Company (the "Corporation"), a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of New York, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is General Security Property and Casualty Company. The name under which the Corporation was formed was Unity Fire Insurance Corporation.
- 2. The Corporation's Charter was filed with the New York State Insurance Department on May 12, 1942.
 - 3. The Corporation's Amended Charter is hereby amended as follows:

Article I of the Corporation's Amended Charter is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The name of this corporation is:

UNITRIN PREFERRED INSURANCE COMPANY.

The first sentence of Article II of the Corporation's Amended Charter is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The principal office of the corporation is to be located in the County of Onondaga, State of New York, and it shall have the power to conduct its business wherever authorized by law. The corporation shall have the power to establish other offices in this state and elsewhere in the United States and in any part of the world to conduct its business wherever authorized by law.

The first sentence of the first paragraph of Article IV of the Corporation's Amended Charter is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The corporate powers of the corporation shall be exercised by a board of directors, each of whom shall be at least eighteen years of age and a majority of whom shall be citizens and residents of the United States and of whom not less than three shall be residents of the State of New York.



The first sentence of the first paragraph of Article V of the Corporation's Amended Charter shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

There shall be an annual meeting of the stockholders of the corporation on the last Friday in April of each year, or on such other day as the directors by resolution or by-law prescribe.

The last sentence of the second paragraph of Article V of the Corporation's Amended Charter is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The corporation may provide in its by-laws for the creation of other offices, the method of election or appointment of incumbents and the filling of vacancies.

4. This Certificate of Amendment of the Amended Charter was duly authorized by written consent of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, effective January 1, 2003, and by the written consent of the sole shareholder of the outstanding shares of common stock of the Corporation effective January 1, 2003.
