### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

# **ARTICLE I - Name**

The name of this corporation is Boyette Air Conditioning, Inc.

### **ARTICLE II - Purpose**

- 1. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and/or all lawful business including, but not limited to, conducting the specific business to engage in each and every phase and/or aspect of air conditioning and heating installation, design and creation, repairs and maintenance, marketing and consulting, related and unrelated activities and any other lawful business within or without the State of Florida.
  - 2. To act on its own behalf in all legal or equitable proceedings or suits.
- 3. To acquire, hold, use, deal in, encumber, dispose of property, real or personal, and any interest therein.
- 4. To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

To enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts and agreements of every kind, for any lawful purposes, with limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, or corporation; and to transact any further and other business necessarily connected with the purposes of this corporation, or calculated to facilitate the same.

- 8. To carry on any or all of its operations and businesses and to promote its objects within the State of Florida or elsewhere, without restriction as to place or amount; and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all the general powers of like corporations.
- 9.
