

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND REDOMESTICATION

OF

UNITED FINANCIAL CASUALTY COMPANY

PREAMBLE:

The United Financial Casualty Company seeks redomestication from the State of Missouri to the State of Ohlo subject to approval by the Superintendent of Insurance pursuant to Section 3913.40 of the Ohlo Revised Code as it now exists or may hereafter be amended. United Financial Casualty Company was incorporated under the laws of the State of Missouri on June 13, 1984. United Financial Casualty Company's current state of domicile address is 11457 Olde Cabin Road, Suite 235, St. Louis, Missouri 63141.

The undersigned does hereby certify that the following Articles supercede and replace any and all prior Articles of Incorporation of United Financial Casualty Company:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be United Financial Casualty Company.

SECOND: The place in the State of Ohio in which the corporation is to establish its principal office is Mayfield Village, Cuyahoga County.

THIRD: The purpose of the corporation is to transact the general insurance business, except life insurance, in any of the kinds of insurance set forth in and authorized by Section 3929.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as it now exists or may hereafter be amended, including issuing insurance contracts, making investments as authorized by law, and, in general, to do all things necessary or incidental to the operation of said business.

FOURTH: The number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding is One Hundred Twenty-Eight (128), which shall be Common Shares, Twenty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$23,500.00) par value.

FIFTH: The amount of capital with which the corporation shall begin business is \$2,500,000 of which amount \$1,500,000 shall constitute paid-in-capital and \$1,000,000 shall constitute contributed surplus.
