AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

This corporation was incorporated on July 8, 1993 effective July 9, 1993 under the name Regency Realty Corporation. Pursuant to Sections 607.1003, 607.1004 and 607.1006, Florida Business Corporation Act, the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation, as restated on November 4, 1996, were approved by the Board of Directors at a meeting held on January 30, 2001 and adopted at a meeting of shareholders on May 1, 2001.
