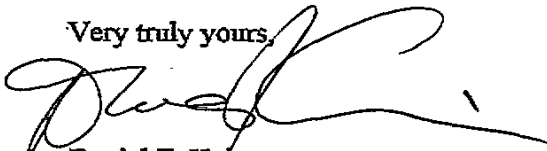

I am writing in regard to the annual report for DFK Trading Corp. On July 1, 1998, a letter was forwarded to your office along with the annual report requesting a waiver of the late filing fee of \$400. It appears that the letter was disregarded and therefore the annual report and the payment of \$150 was returned to the corporation. We thereafter, on or about July 24, 1998 resubmitted our request for abatement and never received a response from your office. Although your records may indicate that a response was sent, we never received such.
