

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LAKE ROSE VILLAGE, INC.

The undersigned incorporators to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name and Address

The name of this corporation is: LAKE ROSE VILLAGE, INC., whose initial principal office is 600 Madison Street, Tampa, Florida 33602.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business permissible by a corporate entity.

ARTICLE III

Powers

This corporation shall have the power:

- (a) To have perpetual succession by its corporate name.
- (b) To sue and be sued, complain, and defend in its

corporate name in all actions or proceedings.

- (c) To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, affixed, or in any other manner reproduced.
- (d) To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

- (f) To lend money to and use its credit to assist its officers and employees to the full extent permitted by law.
- (g) To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (h) To make contracts and guaranties and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, and income.

- (i) To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- (j) To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by the Florida General Corporation Act within or without the State of Florida.
- (k) To elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporation and define their duties and fix their compensation.
