ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BERNARD, CUENCA AND VALDIVIA, INC.

I, the undersigned incorporator, do hereby make, subscribe, execute, acknowledge, and deliver for filing this Certificate of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation will be:

BERNARD, CUENCA AND VALDIVIA, INC.

The principal office and business address is:

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE AND POWERS

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on are, to do any and all things allowed and permitted to be done by corporations under the Statutes of the State of Florida, and to transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act including but not limited to provide architectural, interior design, planning, and facilities management services.

ARTICLE III. STOCK

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OFFICE OF CORPORATIONS
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The stock of this corporation will be divided into 600 shares of stock, at no par value. All said stock will be payable in cash, property, labor, or services, at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors, at a meeting called for that purpose. Property, labor, or services may be purchased or paid for with capital stock, at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors, at a meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE IV. TERM

This corporation will have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. DIRECTORS

The number of directors of this corporation will be not less than one nor more than three. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in such manner as may be prescribed by the By-Laws. A majority vote of the directors shall be required for corporate acts requiring the consent of the Board of Directors.

The corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless each person who shall serve at any time hereafter as a director or officer of the corporation, and any person who serves at the request of this corporation as a director or officer of any other corporation from and against any and all claims and liabilities to which such person shall become subject by reason of his having heretofore or hereafter being a director or officer of the corporation, or by reason of any action alleged to have been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by him as such director or officer, and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any such claim or liability, provided that no person shall be indemnified

against, or be reimbursed for, any expenses incurred in connection with any claim or liability as to which it shall be adjudged that such officer or director is liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duties.

The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions shall not exclude any other right to which he may be lawfully entitled, nor shall anything herein contained restrict the right of the corporation to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically herein provided for.


ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT
