To Whom It May Concern,

It is my understanding that I am severely delinquent on my corporation fees for the Criminal Defense Center, P.A. First and foremost I would like to apologize both for the delay as well as any inconvenience it has caused you and or the members of your office. It is my understanding from a conversation that my secretary had with someone from your office that if you receive a letter explaining the failure to pay said dues timely, I would be merely required to pay \$165.00 as opposed to the heavy late fees normally associated with a delay of this nature.

The only mailing that we received from your office regarding my cooperate fees was a letter explaining that a \$750.00 fee was owed as a result of the delays. Also, the letter explained that my firm was no longer technically a corporation. I had not received any previous bills, mailings, etc. prior to the mailing I'm referring to. While I cannot say with certainty what was the cause for my failure to receive a previous bill, I can suggest a possibility.

Over the past several months the receptionist used by every occupant of the top two floors of my building have only recently been hired. It is their responsibility to receive and sort the mail for every occupant of the top two floors. Since none of these two ladies have more than perhaps fours months experience here, many mistakes and oversights have been made. These mistakes have interrupted the normal receipt of standard mail as well as properly recorded messages. Now that several months have gone by and they are better trained for their position, things have more less returned to normal, exempt for the resolution of mistakes that had previously been made. While I don't know with certainty that this was their fault, I know I never received anything requesting corporate fees.

Normally when I do not receive an expected bill from my creditors, I contact them in order to determine both why a bill has not been received as well as to find out how much money I owe. However, since I have semi-recently become incorporated, I have not received any regular billings for cooperate fees. In other words, since I don't even know with certainty what month I should expect to receive such a bill, I don't know with certainty whether or not it has been delayed. I now know that February is the month that I should be expecting a bill for corporate fees in the future. If I should not receive a bill by that time, I will contact your office immediately.

Once again I deeply regret any inconveniences I have caused anyone in your office and I hope I can resolve this matter with you for the amount of \$165.00. Enclosed please find a check for my cooperate fees in said amount. Please contact me if there are any problems or other matters I need to know about. In the mean time I can assure that this oversight will never happen again and I am...
