Honorable Secretary:


I recently discovered to my great surprise and horror when changing banks that my small corporation was termed "dissolved" by your office. I was incredulous.

I contacted the Division of Corporations to determine the cause which turned out to be due to my "failure" to file an annual report. Upon further investigation it was determined that my "failure" was as a result of the annual report mailing being sent to our former address (from which we have moved two years ago today) and was not forwarded. More importantly, this was more surprising since my office sent out notices to all pertinent State and Federal offices notifying them of our move in 1997. Somehow, your office either did not receive the notice or it was lost and my file not updated.

All of this would not matter, as your office has a remedy. Submit a reinstatement form. However, I was shocked to learn that my fee would be \$900—based on the premise that I am the only party at fault and that the State assumes no accountability or responsibility for contributing to this unintended error.

I feel that the fee is unreasonable high and should be reduced or eliminated in this case. However, since I have been told by your office that if I do not submit the full amount along with this letter, I will delay the reinstatement. I feel threatened by this attitude, as my business is extremely important to me and I cannot afford to be perceived to be out of business. To that end, I am submitting two checks, one for the yearly renewal, the other for the reinstatement fee. My hope is that you will see to a fair decision on this matter and return the second check for reinstatement fees.
