ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is: **JOE'S MOTORS, CORP.**

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation is to exist perpetually. It shall commence its existence upon the signing of these articles of Incorporation by the initial subscribers.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 500 (FIVE HUNDRED) shares of \$1.00 (ONE DOLLAR) per share.

Shares may be issued for such consideration as is determined from time to time by the stockholders.

This power which is hereby reserved unto the stockholders by right, may, and it is hereby delegated, unto the Board of Directors. ARTICLE XIII - POWERS

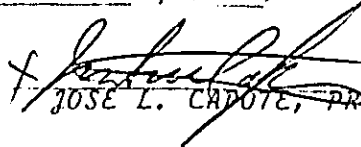
This corporation shall have all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purposes and contemplated in the Florida General Corporation Act.

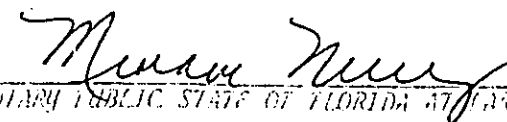

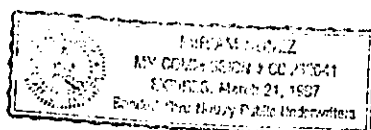

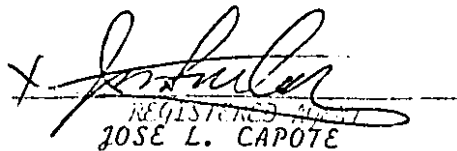
