OF

ARTICLE I. NAME.

The name of the corporation is GATEWAY PUBLISHING, INC..

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE.

The principal office of the Corporation is at 9905 S.W. 131st Street, Miami, in Dade County, State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. REGISTERED AGENT.

- (D) To receive, acquire, hold, pledge, transfer, or otherwise dispose of shares of the corporation;
- (E) To make gifts or contributions for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.

ARTICLE IX. CAPITAL STOCK.

Section 1. Authorized shares. The total number of shares which this Corporation is authorized to issue is One Hundred (100)

Section 2. Preemptive rights. Except as may otherwise be provided by the board of directors, no holder of any shares of the stock of the corporation shall have any preemptive right to purchase, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire any shares of stock of the Corporation of any class now or hereafter authorized, or any securities exchangeable for or convertible into such shares, or any warrants or other instruments evidencing rights or options to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire such shares

ARTICLE X. COMMENCEMENT OF BUSINESS.

Such interested director of directors may be counted in determining whether a quorum is present for the meeting at which such ratification of approval is given. If the interest of such director of directors, is, or was, necessary for the approval of such contract or transaction, then such contract or transaction shall, with disclosure of the director's or directors' interest, be submitted for the approval of or ratification by the stockholders.
