On behalf of our client, the referenced Florida corporation, we are enclosing a completed Application for Reinstatement (Document #P95000076983) along with a check in the amount of \$750.00 as required. We ask that you process the reinstatement of their corporate status and advise them of such as soon as possible.

On behalf of our client I wish an appeal the penalty portion of this assessment, amounting to \$800.00, as the failure to timely file was inadvertent and the result of most unusual extenuating circumstances. We believe upon your review you will agree and allow the refund of the penalty assessment to be made.

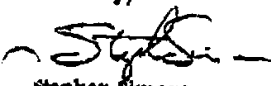
Late in 1998 and early in 1999, the Company was in the process of relocating its offices and had just hired a new bookkeeper to handle the accounting and check writing functions. The prior bookkeeper had stayed for several weeks to train the new employee. The individual was to handle the same tasks for two companies whom, while similar in structure, and are different with regard to the work and services they provide.

After many months of turmoil which was originally attributed to the change of employees, the management of the Companies noticed that even though funds were coming in the bills always did not appear to not be getting fully and/or timely paid. The long and short of the story is that the Company investigated the matter and determined that the new bookkeeper had not only stolen a great deal of money, but had simply thrown away all sorts of tax returns and other forms which had come from both Federal and Florida taxing authorities. This individual was then arrested and is subsequently being prosecuted.

It appears the original and second request for the Annual Corporation Report were disposed of before management had the opportunity to see it and cause it to be timely filed and paid. Accordingly, the Annual Corporate Report was not filed and the renewal not paid until the enclosed application was received by the taxpayers. Upon receipt the document was completed and forwarded to you with the required payment.

As it is quite clear that the failure to file or pay with respect to the Company's 1999 Annual Corporate Report was both inadvertent and unfortunate, we respectfully request that all penalty portion of this assessment be abated and returned to the Company.
