The undersigned incorporator, who is licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice law in the State of Florida, forms his professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, and adopts the following articles of incorporation for the corporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation is Strickland & Molhem, P.A.

ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the corporation's principal office is 101 E. Kennedy Blvd., Suite 1100, Tampa, Florida 33602. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation, located at that office is Richard A. Strickland.

ARTICLE III
DURATION

The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual, or until dissolved on a vote of the shareholders as provided in these articles.

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

- a. To engage in the practice of law as a professional law corporation and to carry on services incident to the practice of law. The practice of law is the sole and exclusive professional service to be rendered by this corporation.
- b. To own property, enter into contracts, and to carry on any business necessary or incidental to the accomplishment or furtherance of the purposes or objects of this corporation.

The professional services of this corporation shall be carried out only through officers, employees, and agents, each of whom has been admitted to the bar of, and is duly authorized to practice law in, the State of Florida.

**ARTICLE V
CAPITAL STOCK**

The total number of shares of stock which the corporation shall be authorized to issue or have outstanding at any one time is 100 shares. These shares shall be of a single class of common stock and shall have a par value of \$1.00 per share.

**ARTICLE VI
CAPITALIZATION**

The amount of capital with which the corporation will begin to practice the profession of law is not less than \$100.00.

**ARTICLE VII
CORPORATE POWERS**

The corporation shall have all the rights and powers now or subsequently conferred on professional corporations by the laws of the State of Florida.

On dissolution, the corporate property and assets shall, after payment of all debts of the corporation, be distributed to the shareholders pro rata, each shareholder to participate in the distribution in the direct proportion to the number of shares held by the shareholder.

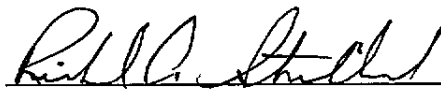
