## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PEED, INC.

- 1. The name of the corporation is PEED, INC.
- 2. Article III of the Articles of Incorporation filed June 1, 1998, is amended to read as follows:

## ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is two thousand (2,000) shares of common, with one dollar (\$1.00) par value per share. One class of stock, consisting of one thousand (1,000) authorized shares, shall be designated "Common Stock" and shall be voting stock. The second class of stock, consisting of one thousand (1,000) authorized shares, shall be designated "Class A Common Stock" and shall be nonvoting stock. There are no preemptive rights.

- 3. The foregoing amendment was adopted unanimously by the Board of Directors and unanimously by the shareholders of this corporation on February 2, 2001.
- 4. The stock certificates of the corporation now issued and outstanding, consisting of 500 shares, are designated "Common, Stock." Certificates of all outstanding stock are to be submitted to the Secretary of the corporation, who shall place on each certificate a legend complying with Section 607.0625(3), Florida Statutes, and return the certificates to the holders thereof.
