ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OLDE WORLD TREASURES, CO.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of "OLDE WORLD TREASURES" CO. "under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is "OLDE WORLD TREASURES, CO." with principal place of business at 1638 South Bayshore Court, Unit 104, Coconut Grove, Florida 33133.

ARTICLE II - COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

ARTICLE IX - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall initially have 1 director. The number of directors may be increased

from time to time, as provided in the Bylaws. The name of the initial director is Roger Machin. Machin. Said director shall have the power and authority to transact all lawful business for this corporation.
