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## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

## BULLARD, HALL & ADAMS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

- Article 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is: Bullard, Hall & Adams, Inc.
- Article 2. Address of principal office. The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the corporation is 1010 Pelican Bay Drive, Daytona Beach, Florida 32119.
- Article 3. Duration. The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.
- Article 4. Purpose. The general purposes for which the Corporation is organized are the following:
- A. To engage in and transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act. No other purpose limits this general purpose in any way.
- B. To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

Shares held by each Shareholder may not be sold or otherwise transferred to other persons unless first offered to this Corporation or to the remaining Shareholders in proportion to their The price, terms and other provisions regarding this restriction may be specified by written agreement among the Shareholders, which agreement may expand this Article and which may also include the Corporation as a party.

Article 13. Rights of Initial Directors. Each of the initial Directors shall have the right to be a Director of the Corporation as long as that respective Director is a Shareholder of the Corporation. By acquiring stock in this Corporation, each Shareholder agrees to abide by this right and to elect each of the initial Directors named in these Articles of Incorporation to the office of Director as along as that Director is a Shareholder of the Corporation. This Article may not be amended in any way without the written consent of each of the initial Directors who is a Shareholder of the Corporation at the time of the amendment.
