ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SEABOARD CORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the Corporation is SEABOARD CORPORATION. The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is 11440 N. Kendall Dr., Suite 201, Miami FL 33176.

ARTICLE II TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law and such existence shall commence at the time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State.
