To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in reference to my recent discovery that the account for my corporation, Jaga Ironing and Alteration Services, Inc., has been administratively dissolved as of September 19, 2003 due to not filing of the 2003 Annual Business Report.

The facts are as follows:

1. In January 2003 I mailed the Annual Business Report with the attached check for \$150.00 (check #141, copy of the check register enclosed).
2. In the Report, I changed the mailing address from 748 Belvill Blvd., Naples, FL 34104 to 3440 3rd Ave SW, Naples, FL 34117 – I moved in July 2002.
3. I have not received any correspondence from Department of State, except for the initial 2003 Annual Business Report application.
4. Based on the above 3 points, I assumed that everything was in order with the Florida filing.
5. In 2004, during the preparation of the 2003 tax return for Jaga Ironing, it was discovered that the check for \$150.00 that I mailed in January 2003 with the UBR, never cleared the bank.
6. A quick check on www.sunbiz.org confirmed my fear, that the report never reached the Division of State. My corporation was listed as inactive.
7. I contacted the state asking if any remainder notices were mailed to me and they were, but unfortunately due to my moving, the Post Office stopped forwarding the mail to my new address in February 2003, and therefore, no correspondence from Department of State has reached me.

Due to the above circumstances and the fact that there was no willful neglect on my side, I kindly ask you to abate the \$900.00 of the reinstatement fees and instead accept this attached check for \$300.00 as a payment for 2003 and 2004 Uniform Business Reports. I am running a small corporation with gross receipts not exciding \$30,000 a year and a penalty of \$900.00 would greatly affect my financial situation.
