ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of Lawrence L. Ressler, D.M.D., P.A. under the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE II. ADDRESS

ARTICLE III. COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation will commence upon the filing of these Articles with the Office of the Secretary of State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

This corporation is intended to be a professional corporation engaging in the practice of dentistry and a professional service corporation within the meaning of the Professional Service Corporation Act. Accordingly, the corporation, its officers and stockholders shall be subject to all of the sections of said Act concerning the formation of the corporation, the conduct of its business, and the liabilities, rights, privileges, and immunities of the corporation, its officers and stockholders, as stated in Chapter 621, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE V. AUTHORIZED SHARES

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is 1,000 shares of common stock having \$1.00 par value per share.

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The right of indemnification herein provided shall not be exclusive of other rights to which any such person may now or hereafter be entitled as a matter of law.


ARTICLE X. BYLAWS


