AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KIRK PHARMACEUTICALS, INC.

SECHEMANT OF STATE TALLAHASSEE. FLORIDA

- 1. The name of the Corporation is Kirk Pharmaceuticals, Inc.
- 2. The Articles of Incorporation are amended to repeal ARTICLE III SHARES and substitute therein the following.

"ARTICLE III SHARES

The Corporation is authorized to issue Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand (850,000) shares of voting common stock at a par value of \$.002 per share and One Hundred Fifty Thousand (150,000) shares of nonvoting common stock at a par value of \$.002 per share. The voting common stock of the Corporation shall have the following characteristics:

- a. Par value of \$.002 per share.
- b. At all meetings of the stockholders the voting common stock shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote for each share of voting common stock owned. The fact that a voting common stockholder is interested in a matter to be voted upon shall not disqualify him from voting thereon.
- c. Except as otherwise provided by law, the entire voting power of the election of directors and for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the holders of the outstanding voting common stock.
- d. Other than with respect to voting rights, the voting and nonvoting common stock shall have identical rights."

3. The foregoing amendment was adopted by resolution of the shareholders dated February 12, 2002. The number of votes cast by the shareholders for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
