The event, which takes place from 10 a.m. to 1 pm., is sponsored by the city, which has contracted with a company called Stred-it to recycle all of the paper materials, according to City Clerk Sally Maio. "Councilman Eugene Wolff actually first suggested the idea and we brought it to the City Council." said Maio. She said that the city uses the service to dispose of sensitive paper documents. After shredding, all of the paper material is recycled.


