

The mission of the Foundation is:

To lower the number of injuries and fatalities of motorcyclists caused by drivers of motor vehicles violating the right-of-way of the motorcyclist through the promotion of awareness and education of the general driving public.

The idea for a group dedicated to making the general driving public of Florida more aware of motorcyclists had been floating between Hark and Monk since the inception of Dixie Biker Illustrated. Several events in 2001 brought an idea to fruition.

February 2001. Hark attempted to get some interest going in our Legislature about getting a Proclamation passed that would name March as Motorcycle Awareness Month in Florida. He was rebuffed in his efforts for several reasons: he was just one man against an entire system; we had no time to lobby; and we had no time to ask Dixie Biker Illustrated readers to help in the efforts.

Many states, Florida included, have May designated as Motorcycle Awareness Month because it is the start of the traditional riding season. That is not the case in Florida. We ride year-round and March is the month of Bike Week. A half a million bikers would be in Daytona for the event; the driving public would already be aware of motorcyclists; and we thought a proclamation from Governor Bush would reinforce awareness to the driving public. It would, hopefully, get air-play and newspaper space during a critical time of year. One other thing that's really driving us is that Florida has over 240,000 registered motorcycles, trailing only California and Ohio. Further, it has an aging population with driver's licenses that are renewable by mail for up to twelve years. That's right no eye examination required. No testing, written or driving, either.

April 2001. Rusty McIntire, a good friend of Fly and Lexy, two of Dixie Biker Illustrated's moto-journalists was killed while riding home from work. Rusty was traveling about 50 mph when a driver pulled out in front of his Goldwing. Rusty left a widow and four children. Lexy wrote an article that touched the hearts of our readers and elicited several letters to the editor.

June 2001. Fly was riding home from work, traveling about forty in a 55 mph zone, when a van pulled directly in his path. Fifteen feet is not enough room to stop a Road King. He went down. The Road King is in three pieces, his right leg is in thirteen. He may walk again in the Summer of 2002.

July 2001. Dixie Biker Illustrated publishes Lexy's article on Fly's accident. It publishes a Letter to the Editor from Becky Mariotti and asks other bikers to get involved.

August 2001. Two meetings are held - one in Jacksonville and one

September 2001. Seed money is raised through a Poker Run with three start-points: Jacksonville, Gainesville and Daytona areas all riding to Palatka. About 100 motorcyclists participate and offer input regarding the goals and mission of what we're trying to do.

The Foundation is incorporated as a Non-profit Corporation in Florida.

Necessary forms and paperwork are filed to secure a ruling from the Internal Revenue Service to be a Tax Exempt organization under 501(c) (3).

Necessary forms to register Trademarks, logos and slogans are filed to protect intellectual ideas of members of the Foundation.



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
