## MOSQUITO BIOLOGY AND HABITS

- The females have an elongated proboscis (mouth part), which is firm and is usually adapted for piercing and sucking blood, which is needed to start the reproductive cycle.
- There are four life stages: egg, larva, pupa, and adult. The female mosquito, (according to the species) may deposit her eggs on water, on the sides of containers where water will soon cover them, or on damp soil where they must undergo a maturing process before they can hatch when flooded by rainfall or high tides.
  - Generally mosquitoes can be divided into three major breeding groups: permanent water breeders, floodwater breeders and artificial container/tree hole breeders. After the tiny eggs hatch, the larvae begin to feed on very small plant and animal particles, most larva breath air at the surface of the water they inhabit. In a short time they become pupa, which do not feed, (this is the resting stage of development and is brief). When the pupa is mature, it becomes an adult mosquito and flies away in search of a mate and in the case of the female a blood meal to start the reproductive cycle. The blood meal is taken from a preferred host, which is usually an animal.
- Most species are active and bite mainly in the early evening.
- Florida mosquitoes breed mainly in the spring and summer when the temperatures and rainfall are ideal for development.

## MOSQUITOES AS A HEALTH CONCERN IN FLORIDA

- West Nile Virus, which is transmitted by mosquito's, to humans, birds and horses can cause
  encephalitis (i.e. inflammation of the brain) and, in the most severe cases, death. At this
  time there is no definitive treatment for West Nile Virus. Prevention via appropriate
  mosquito control measures is the key to keeping your family, horses & livestock virus free.
  While Middleton cannot guarantee the absence of mosquito borne illnesses, our mosquito
  management service does reduce the mosquito population.
- A chief medical concern in Florida at the present time is the possibility of an arthropodborn encephalitis epidemic. Viruses of Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Western Equine Encephalitis, and St. Louis Encephalitis have been found in mosquitoes in the state.
- Secondary infections may result from scratching mosquito bites. And there are people
  who are allergic to the bites.



## TREATMENT PROGRAM

**Step One:** Inspection of the property to identify mosquito-breeding sites. Consulting with the homeowner on proper methods of

eliminating breeding sites. Treatment of breeding sites using a larvicide when necessary.

Rapid reduction of adult population around the home. This will be accomplished by treating the lawn and shrubs with a

contact adulticide monthly (April – September) to reduce the adult mosquito population on the property.

The use of a mechanical device (mosquito trap) can help to suppress the adult population between treatment applications.

Middleton service is not dependent on these mechanical devices.


