ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOUTHEASTERN CLINICAL SERVICES, P.A.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 607.1006 of the Florida Statutes, Southeastern Clinical Services, P.A., a professional service corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

Section 1 - Name

The name of the corporation is Southeastern Clinical Services, P.A. (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

Section 2 - Adoption and Text of Amendments

All of the members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation approved the following resolution amending the Articles of Incorporation by written consent dated November 13, 1998, in accordance with the provisions of Section 607.0821 of the Florida Statutes, and all of the Shareholders of the Corporation approved the resolution amending the Articles of Incorporation by written consent dated November 1998, in accordance with the provisions of Section 607.0704 of the Florida Statutes:

RESOLVED, that Article III, Paragraph A, of the Amendment and Restatement of Articles of Incorporation shall be amended as follows:

"The maximum number of shares of stock that the Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is Ten Thousand (10,000), 69 which One Thousand (1,000) shares having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share shall be shares of voting common stock, and Nine Thousand (9,000) shares having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share shall be shares of non-voting common stock.

The preferences, qualifications, limitations and restrictions, and the special or relative rights with respect to the shares of voting and non-voting common stock, are as follows:

Holders of voting common stock of the Corporation shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each share of voting common stock standing in his, her or its name at any and all meetings of the shareholders of the Corporation. Holders of non-voting common stock shall not be entitled to cast any vote on account of ownership of such stock.

Except for the difference in voting rights set forth above, the rights, preferences, qualifications, limitations and restrictions, and the special or relative rights and features with respect to the shares of non-voting common stock shall be identical in all respects to those of the shares of voting common stock."
