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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of SISTERS AND BROTHERS FOREVER, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendments to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted: ARTICLE 3 a) changed and ARTICLE 11 added. ARTICLE 3 a) should read as follows:

a) this corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. To further such purposes this corporation will work to provide assistance to disadvantaged groups. Such groups include, but are not limited to, political refugees during their first times in the United States, people negatively affected by Welfare Reform, and in general the distressed and/or underprivileged. That assistance includes, but is not limited to, teaching English skills, job referral, medical help especially psychiatry and affordable housing.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was: June 18, 1997.

THIRD: Adoption of Amendment.

ARTICLE 11- Dissolution

The amendment was adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
