### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### OPTIMIST CLUB OF PENSACOLA BEACH, INC.

(A Florida Corporation Not For Profit)

I, the undersigned, as President of the Optimist Club of Pensacola Beach, an unincorporated association, desiring to incorporate a corporation not for profit in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 617, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, do make and file these Articles of Incorporation.

### ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be OPTIMIST CLUB OF PENSACOLA BEACH, INC.

### **ARTICLE II. DURATION, AND OFFICE ADDRESS**

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual and its existence shall commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State. ### **ARTICLE III. PURPOSE**
