AMENDMENTS OF THE DECLARATION OF
TRUST OF LAWYERS' TITLE GUARANTY FUND

We, the undersigned, being more than three-fourths of the Trustees of LAWYERS' TITLE GUARANTY FUND, in pursuance of resolutions previously duly adopted by affirmative votes of more than three-fourths of said Trustees, hereby further amend the declaration of trust of Lawyers' Title Guaranty Fund filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida on March 22, 1947, and as heretofore amended by amendments filed in said office on April 26, 1950; February 15, 1951; April 5, 1951; June 3, 1955; December 22, 1956; October 9, 1959; November 9, 1960; and October 4, 1966.

The amendment now made is as follows:

Section 39 is amended to read as follows:

Section 39. INTEGRITY OF FUND: The integrity of The Fund must be maintained. Any payment to or withdrawal by any member, which, if made would reduce The Fund's surplus to policyholders as determined from the last sworn statement on file with the Insurance Commissioner of Florida below the amount required by law plus the collective excess, if any, of the fair market value of listed securities over the book value, which shall mean cost or amortized cost as carried on the books of The Fund, and plus One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), or such an increased amount as the Trustees in their discretion may fix from time to time, shall be deferred until making it will not reduce the Fund's surplus to policyholders, as above defined, below such amount. Any discretionary authority in the Trustees to make payments or distributions or to allow any withdrawals shall be exercised by the adoption from time to time of procedural policies applicable to all similar circumstances while they are in effect, and shall be subject to the above limitation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, being more than three-fourths of the duly elected qualified and acting Trustees of Lawyers' Title Guaranty Fund, 19 in number, have hereunto set our respective hands and seals this 22nd day of May, 1968.




