ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNDERSIGNED incorporator, for purposes of forming a Florida corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act (Florida Statutes, Chapter 607), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

- FIRST:** The name of the corporation is:
MedicInvestor, Inc. (the "Corporation").
- SECOND:** The principal office address and mailing address of the Corporation is: 1600 Massachusetts Avenue, #805, Cambridge, Massachusetts 02138.
- THIRD:** The Corporation is authorized to issue 10,000 shares of common stock, par value \$.01 per share.
- FOURTH:** The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is: c/o McDermott, Will & Emery, 201 South Biscayne Boulevard, Suite 2200, Miami, Florida 33131; and the registered agent at that address is Joseph I. Zumpano.

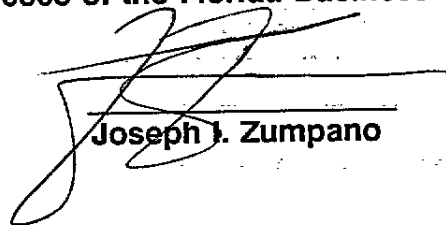
