ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FILED 98 MAY 21 AM II: 00

THE TOM KANEY BENEVOLENT MEDICAL FUND, INC. TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned incorporator hereby executes these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of this corporation shall be:

THE TOM KANEY BENEVOLENT MEDICAL FUND, INC.

ARTICLE 2

<u>Purposes</u>

- (a) The purposes for which this corporation is organized are to provide financial assistance with treatment and medical expenses for individuals suffering from acute medical problems, and to engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit.
- (b) This corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes. As means for the accomplishment of the foregoing, it shall be within the purposes of this corporation to make distributions of income to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any statute of similar import (the "Code"), and to take any other action which, from time to time, shall seem expedient to the Directors of this corporation and which shall further the said purposes.
- (c) No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Director, officer of this corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for this corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no Director or officer of this corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on

dissolution of this corporation. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

- (d) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or the regulations issued thereunder, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code and regulations issued thereunder.
- (e) Upon the dissolution of this corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of this corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, scientific or educational organizations which then would qualify for the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and the regulations issued thereunder, and no Director, officer or private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the assets.

ARTICLE 3

Powers

- (a) This corporation shall have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any and all of the charitable, scientific and educational purposes for which this corporation is organized.
- (b) This corporation shall neither have nor exercise any power, nor shall it engage directly or indirectly in any activity that would invalidate its status:
 - (1) As a corporation that is exempt from federal income taxation as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; or
 - (2) As a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

ARTICLE 4

Members

This corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE 5

Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 6

Registered Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered office of this corporation shall be located at 2909 Bay to Bay Blvd., Ste. 309, Tampa, Florida 33629, and the initial registered agent of this corporation at such office shall be Thomas P. McNamara. This corporation shall have the right to change such registered agent and such registered office from time to time, as provided by law. The principal office address and the mailing address of the corporation is 308 E. 7th Avenue, Tampa, FL 33602.

Officers and Directors

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors who shall be elected by the Board of Directors, and by officers who shall be elected by the Board of Directors. The officers thus to be elected shall be a president, a secretary and a treasurer and such other officers as may be provided for in the bylaws of this corporation. The duties of the respective officers and the manner of filling vacancies in the offices of this corporation shall be as provided in the bylaws.
