Title

Corrections and Additions to Article III of the Incorporation

The purpose of this corporation is to engage in the organization and running of scholastic and open chess programs and tournaments in South Florida.

The Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (C) (3), of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article X (Amendment)

These Articles of incorporation may be amended, changed, altered, or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

(Add) Article XI General

No part of the net earnings of the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

(Add) Article XII. Other Provisions

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

(Add) Article X1II. Dedications of Assets

Upon the dissolution of the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association, its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of Miami-Dade County which is the principal office for the area where the Miami-Dade Scholastic Chess Association is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

The undersigned incorporator has executed these Amended Articles of Corporation the 29th day of July 1998.

These Articles of Incorporation are hereby adopted this 31st day of July 1998 by majority vote of the Board of Directors.
