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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MICHAEL G. AHEARN, P.A.



The undersigned subscriber to these articles of incorporation, being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the state of Florida, adopts these articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 621, and other laws of the state of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the professional service corporation is: Michael G. Ahearn, P.A.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

If any shareholder becomes legally disqualified to practice law in the state of Florida, is elected to a public office, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on the continuous rendering of such professional services, that shareholder's shares of stock shall immediately become subject to purchase by the professional service corporation in accordance with the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT.

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions in these articles of incorporation in the manner provided by law. Any right conferred on the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
