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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONSIGN OF THE TIMES, INC., a Florida corporation

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is CONSIGN OF THE TIMES, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The Corporation is organized for the purposes of transacting any or all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the laws of the United States and the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - Capital Stock

The Corporation is authorized to issue 10,000 shares of US \$.01 par value common stock. The Corporation shall indemnify and shall advance expenses on behalf of its officers and directors to the fullest extent permitted by law in existence either now or hereafter.


ARTICLE IX - Fiscal Year
