that time it was to late, I lost my home. Mr. Rosado did not want any thing more to do with the business. I recovered the so called books, only to find that nothing had been done. For the rest of the year I lived out of my Van and tried to get the business and myself back on track.

October 4, 2005 I received a call from the Police in Jacksonville requesting that I come and Pick up My daughter and her brother and baby sister, that the mother was doing Crack cocaine. I was still living out of my Van. At that time the children and myself ended up living in a construction site for three months until I saved up enough money to rent a house. Between working, paying for day care, going to family court every two weeks to meet all the requirements to keep the children and caring for a Two year old girl, a four year old boy, and a seven year old girl which is my daughter, and trying to find suitable housing, as you can see, I had my hand full. In January 30, 2006 I found the house at 4148 Pine Road and moved in. The next problem was to furnish the house and meet the children needs, while trying to locate the other children fathers. So far the little boy has been returned to his biological father. The two year old little girl has no one, her father is in prison and non of the other relatives want her, so I am going to court to adopt her.

During all that has transpired, I ended up loosing my index finger to a chop saw while on the job trimming out a house. It was my left index finger and I am left handed. With no health insurance I have now ended up another \$20,000.00 in Debt. Contract Warranty Extenders Inc. at the end of year 2005 lost \$35,000.00, at the end of 2006 the company had losses of (\$-15,784.00), This was due to a slow down in the Housing market. For the year 2007 Contract Warranty Extenders Inc. Should have all debts paid and show a profit and then I'll start working on getting my personal debt of close to \$90,000.00. I have worked long and hard to get to a point that the company has a good reputation and client base. The business is growing but I need help to get through this problem with the Exemption and Corp. filing for 2005 and 2006.

Being a disabled Veteran rated at 50% and very close to 60 years of age I am trying very hard to be a very good father and not to be a burden to society and with your help this time I am sure that my company and I will be very successful.



The Corporation was opened in 09/16/05 due to the fact that the Law had changed for workers comp exemption, requiring the business to become a corporation to meet the requirements set forth by the state. At the time I did not have the money required to set up the corporation, so I borrowed it from a friend which owed me a favor, Becquer Rosado, he was to handle the paper work and the books and I the day to day operation of the business, supplying equipment, vehicles, trailers, materials for start up, and paying \$1,500.00 for the Payroll Service to supply Workers Comp for the employees. I refinanced my home on Claremont Circle for \$15,000.00 to pay for equipment and money for start-up funds, in return Mr. Rosado would receive twenty five percent of the stock and the title of President for one year, with twenty four percent of the stock for future growth, and the remaining fifty one percent to me and that I maintain control as CEO of the company.

The first couple of months of operation of the company went will, the business started to grow. Mr. Rosado started to employ his friends and family. He no longer wanted to do the books, so he hired his son's girl friend. The company's payroll started to get out of control. People were getting paid for doing nothing. The company was making money but, not enough to cover expenditures, I started to use my personal money to cover the shortages. This went on for several months, until I had enough, but by
