ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Not for Profit Corporation, In Compliance with Chapter 617, Maistan OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be the Pinellas County Sheriff Charities Corporation.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial officers/directors of the corporation are as follows:

Specifically, Jim Coats, Pinellas County Sheriff, in his official capacity, shall serve as President and Secretary/Treasurer of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII

ARTICLE VIII

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
