



Article II – Purposes

The primary purpose of this Organization shall be:

- 1. To form a representative body capable of developing group opinions in a professional manner to speak with authority for teachers.
- 2. To provide an opportunity for continuous study and take action on problems of the profession.
- 3. To encourage cooperation and communication between the profession and the community.
- 4. To keep teachers informed of meetings and relevant cultural events.
- 5. To increase the interest in the study of Portuguese language in the U.S.A.

Article IV - Officers and Executive Board

Section 4 -

- a. The terms of officers and advisory board shall be two years. Each of the 8 officers shall be elected members of the executive board.
- b. Whenever there is a vacancy in any office or advisory board position, and before the term is expired, the President will appoint a substitute until a special meeting for election is held. The Executive board will vote for approval on the President's choice of substitute.
- c. If the vacancy is the presidency, then the Vice President will assume presidency until an election meeting is called.

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Article V - Duties of the Executive Board

Section 1: The president shall:

- a. Be the chief executive officer of the Organization
- b. Preside at all meetings of the Organization
- c. Supervise the Executive Board
- d. Exercise such other powers as may from time to time be conferred on him/her by the executive board

Section 2: The Vice President Shall:

- a. Exercise the duties of President in the absence of that officer
- b. Take charge of activities as are assigned to him/her by the President.

Section 3: The Secretary shall:

- a. Preserve the written minutes of board meetings and send copies to all members of the executive board, which will be reviewed and approved at the next meeting.
- b. Give copies of the Organization's by-Laws to Officers upon their election.
- c. Preside over the meetings in the absence of the President and Vice President.
- d. Keep a historical account of all Organization events, including flyers, programs, newsletters, etc.
- e. Engage in all membership issues, such as, recruitment, updated membership forms, and announcement of scheduled meetings.

Section 4: The Treasurer shall:

- a. The Treasurer shall oversee the financial operations of the Organization and shall present reports on the Organization's financial operations and status to the executive board and at the organization's Annual General Membership meeting.
- b. Preside over meetings in the absence of the President, Vice President, and Secretary.

Section 5. The Advisory Board shall:

a. Assist the Board of Directors in implementing the objectives of the Organization by offering advice and counsel, and by performing those duties that may from time to time be assigned them by the President or the Board of Directors.

Article VI - Personal and E-mail Information

Personal and E-mail information is maintained for the exclusive use of the executive board of AOTP for organizational purposes only.

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Article VII – Meetings

- 1. There shall be an Annual Meeting of the entire membership of the Organization held at a time and place to be determined by the Executive Board.
- 2. Special meetings of the Organization may be called by the president at such time and place and with such notice as he or she may determine.
- 3. The executive board shall meet regularly to conduct the affairs and activities of the Organization at a time and place to be selected by the President.
- 4. Six Executive Board members constitute a quorum.
- 5. Traditionally, the Executive Board meets every two months.
- 6. A quorum for all meetings of the AOTP shall consist of fifty-one percent of all voting members present.
- 7. Written notice of the membership meeting stating the location, date, time, and purpose shall be delivered by e-mail to the voting members not less than 15 days before the date of such meeting.

Article X - Amendments to the Constitution

The constitution is subject to amendment. Any member who wishes to propose an amendment to the constitution will send his or hers proposal in writing to the President, Vice-President or Secretary. The Executive Board will then evaluate it on its next regular meeting. After reviewing it and if approved by the board, the proposal will be presented to the members for approval.
