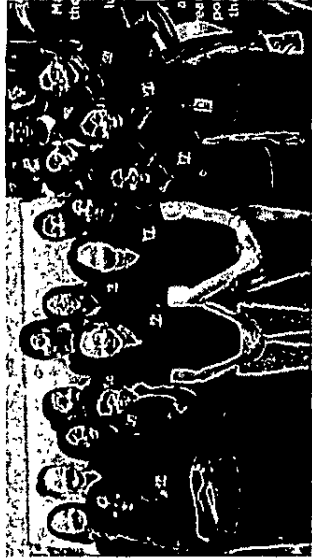

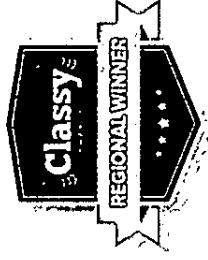
Close to 150 VIP and celebrity guests turned out to cheer on the Detroit Tigers and support the Women of Tomorrow Mentor & Scholarship Program's first Detroit area fundraiser. "Go to Bat for Detroit's Young Women of Tomorrow" was held on October 3, 2012 at the Tigers, Comerica Park, for the last game of the regular season. 1984 Tigers World Series champions Dan Petry & Dave Rozema joined former sports journalist, Event Honorary Chair & Women of Tomorrow Mentor, Karie Dombrowski, to greet the crowds and raise money for Women of Tomorrow Mentees, while they cheered on Miguel Cabrera as he became the first player in 45 years to win the Triple Crown.

Honorary Chair and Tigers General Manager, David Dombrowski, who was in Kansas City with the Tigers, thanked guests via video for attending the event and supporting Women of Tomorrow. The Tigers, who beat the Kansas City Royals, showed their support for the city, not only through the excitement of the game, but also as philanthropic leaders in the community as co-sponsors of the Women of Tomorrow event. Other VIP guests included: Weight Watchers President, Florine Mark; WDIV News Director, Kim Voet Potter; Southfield Mayor, Brenda Lawrence; and Ward Williston Oil Company President, Laurie Cunningham. Event Co-Chairs & Women of Tomorrow Mentors, Ellen Hill Zeringue, VP of Marketing at the Detroit Tigers; and Til Levesque, Former President/Market Manager at Clear Channel Detroit, along with Elaine Lewis, VP of Community & Public Affairs at the Detroit Tigers, opened the program and spoke about the important changes that they have seen in the mentees in the one year the program has been in Detroit.

The event kicked off Women of Tomorrow's second year of mentoring at-risk young girls in Detroit public high schools. This year, the program is partnering with 22 Metro Detroit public high schools, mentoring approximately 500 at-risk girls.

The program has a network of over 350 highly accomplished professional women that serve as mentors

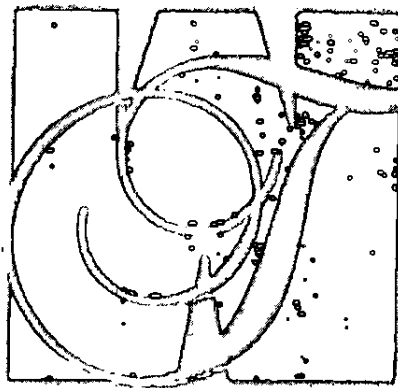
Since 1997, Women of Tomorrow has awarded over \$3 million in scholarships to more than 1,000 deserving young women

The program serves 108 public high schools in South Florida and 22 in Metro Detroit

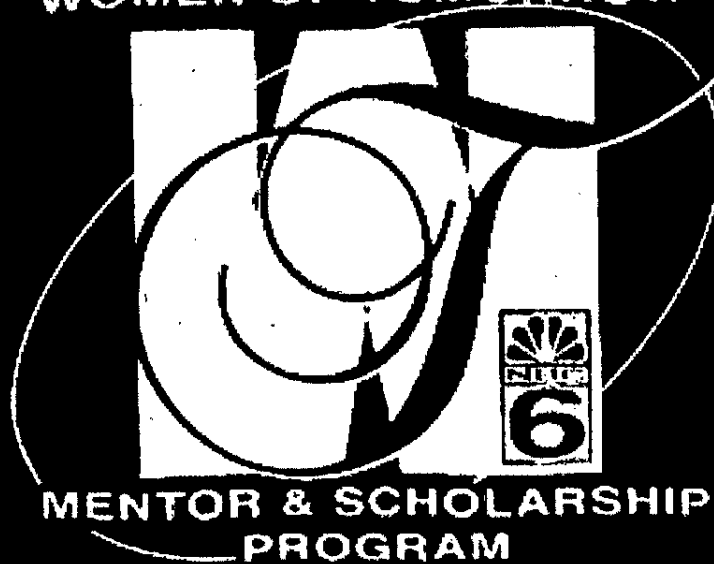
The CLASSY Awards is the largest awards ceremony in the country celebrating philanthropic and charitable initiatives, nonprofit organizations, and socially conscious businesses

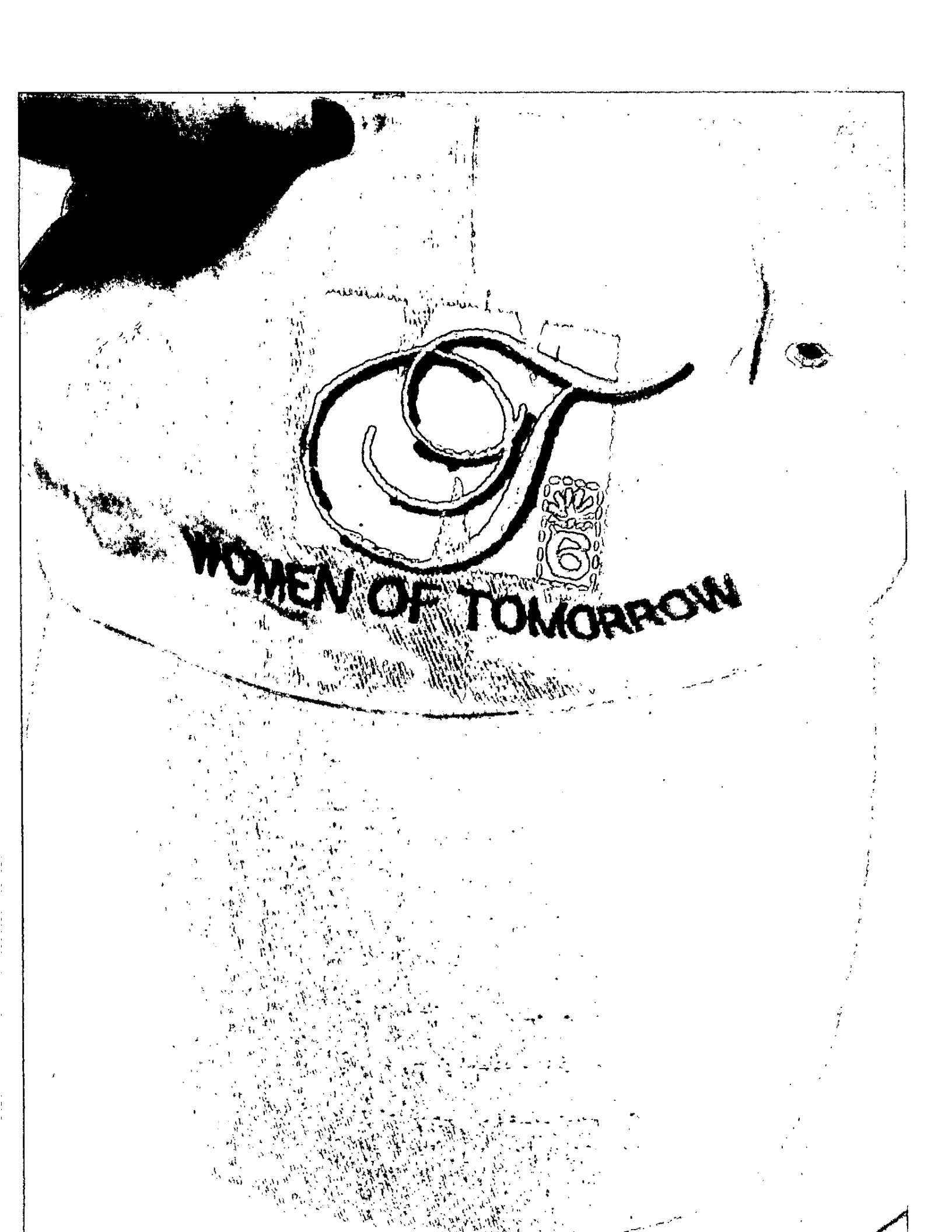

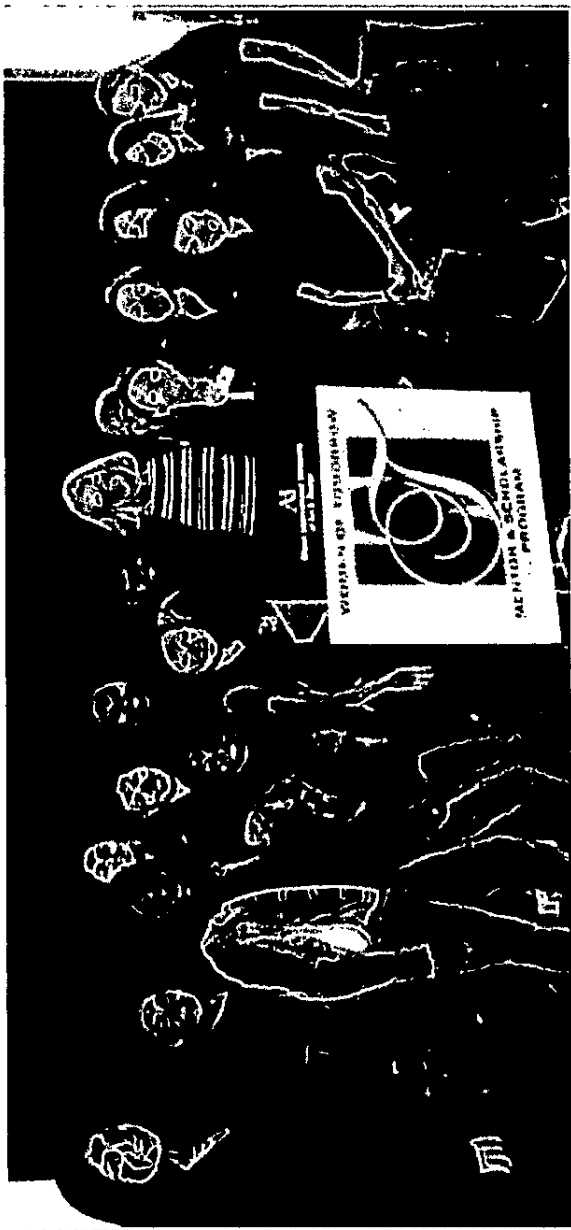

An initial study showed a statistically significant improvement in the self-esteem of the young girls participating in the program. Recent analysis has shown that Women of Tomorrow mentees demonstrate a statistically significant increase in their grade point averages (GPA) each year they are involved in WOT. In addition, WOT mentees graduate from high school at a 92% rate.



Our Model

WOT is believed to be the only program of its kind in the country, pairing extremely accomplished professional women with small groups of at-risk teenage girls in public high schools for monthly mentoring sessions in a three to four year mentoring program. WOT mentors are highly accomplished professional women including judges, doctors, lawyers, airplane pilots, newscasters, executives, and entrepreneurs who are dedicated to showing WOT mentees all the possibilities that exist.

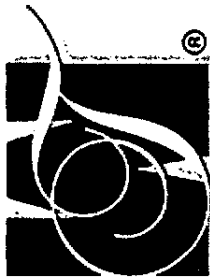

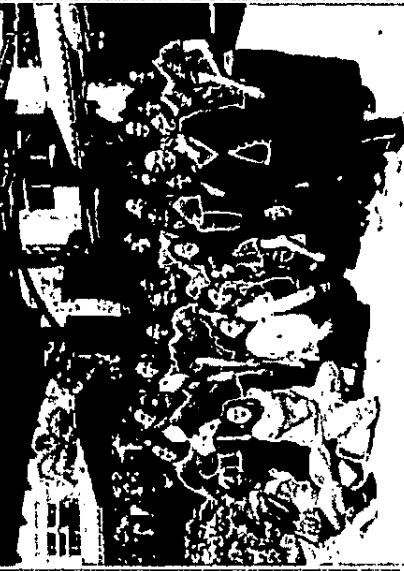

WOT Mentees are part of a small group of young women at their high schools who meet once per month with at least one Women of Tomorrow mentor throughout their high school careers. Mentees participate in monthly mentoring sessions, career-focused field trips, specialized college campus visits and in 12th grade may apply

for WOT scholarship opportunities to pursue higher education.

Mentees start WOT in 9th or 10th grade and stay in the program throughout their high school careers. In any given WOT Mentoring Group, there are Mentees in all four grade levels -- 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades. Mentees are diverse young women with differing strengths and weaknesses so they may learn from and help each other in addition to benefitting from the mentoring they receive.

Mentees are selected for participation in the WOT Program by their school based WOT school coordinators. All mentees must complete annual mentee applications or mentee update forms, corresponding releases and the mentee pledge. While participation in the WOT Program is voluntary, once enrolled, all Mentees are required to attend all Mentoring Sessions and must have no unexcused absences to be eligible for WOT scholarship opportunities.



Upon completion of Women of Tomorrow, mentees have been provided skills for success; exposed to various educational opportunities and career paths; and encouraged to participate actively in their communities.

WOT Graduates who have completed their higher educational endeavors are encouraged to come back to Women of Tomorrow as junior mentors.

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
