ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE BURD FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC.

To further common purposes, the undersigned persons agree to organize under Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be THE BURD FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II ENABLING LAW

This corporation is organized pursuant to the Corporations Not For Profit law of the State of Florida, set forth in Part One of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

- a. The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and education within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- b. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a Not For Profit organization exempt from federal income tax or of the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE IV TERM

All voting rights and other rights, interests and privileges of the Board of Directors shall be equal.

ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

(a) BOARD OF DIRECTORS. The Powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its

properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of at least three (3) directors. The number of directors herein provided for may be changed by a By-Law duly adopted by the Board of Directors entitled to vote.
