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**AMENDED AND RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
COLLEGE FUNDING SPECIALISTS INC.**

Pursuant to Section 607.1007 of the Business Corporation Act of the State of Florida, the undersigned, being the president and chief executive officer of COLLEGE FUNDING SPECIALISTS INC., (hereinafter the "**Corporation**"), a Florida corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 607 of laws of the State of Florida, and desiring to amend and restate its Articles of Incorporation, does hereby certify:

1. The name of the corporation is COLLEGE FUNDING SPECIALISTS INC.
2. The Articles of Incorporation, as amended, of the Corporation were initially filed with the Secretary of State of Florida on May 24, 2007, Document #P07000061982.
3. That at the effective time of this Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, each share of Common Stock of the Corporation issued and outstanding as of the record date set by the Corporation's Board of Directors shall be subject to an eighty (80) for one (1) forward split (the "**Forward Stock Split**") with all fractional shares rounded to the nearest whole share. Such Forward Stock Split shall not affect (i) the number of authorized shares of the Corporation's Common Stock except as herein specified, or (ii) the par value of the Corporation's common stock except as herein specified.
4. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the Board of Directors on May __, 2018, and by Unanimous Written Consent of the Shareholders on May 30, 2018. To effect the foregoing, the text of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended and restated as herein set forth in full and shall supersede the original Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of this Corporation shall be: COLLEGE FUNDING SPECIALISTS INC.

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be 1825 Main Street, Weston, Florida 33326.

**ARTICLE III
NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS AND POWERS**

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation shall be to engage in any and all lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

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**ARTICLE IV
CAPITAL STOCK**

The maximum number of shares that this Corporation shall be authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time shall be 1,000,000 shares of Common Stock.

**ARTICLE V
TERM OF EXISTENCE**

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

**ARTICLE VI
REGISTERED AGENT AND ADDRESS**

**ARTICLE VIII
INDEMNIFICATION**

To the fullest extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act, the Corporation shall indemnify, or advance expenses to, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that such person (i) is or was a director of the Corporation; (ii) is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director of another corporation, provided that such person is or was at the time a director of the Corporation; or (iv) is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as an officer of another Corporation, provided that such person is or was at the time a director of the corporation or a director of such other corporation, serving at the request of the Corporation. Unless otherwise expressly prohibited by the Florida Business Corporation Act, and except as otherwise provided in the previous sentence, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the sole and exclusive discretion, on such terms and conditions as it shall determine, to indemnify, or advance expenses to, any person made, or threatened to be made, a party to any action, suit, or proceeding by reason of the fact such person is or was an officer, employee or agent of the Corporation as an officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.

AFFILIATED TRANSACTIONS**

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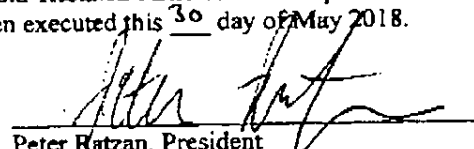
This Corporation expressly elects not to be governed by Section 607.0901 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, as amended from time to time, relating to affiliated transactions.

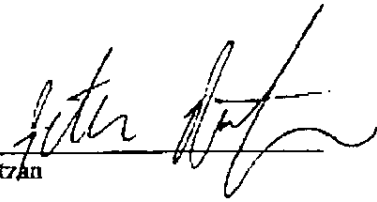
