

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CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PHOENIX TOWERS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned officers of **Phoenix Towers Condominium Association**, **Inc.** do hereby certify that the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation are a true and correct copy as amended, pursuant to Article X thereof, by the membership at a duly called and noticed meeting of the members held **February 10**, **2003**. The amendments were adopted by the members and the number of votes amendment was sufficient for approval.

AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PHOENIX TOWERS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

(Additions shown by "underlining", deletions shown by "strikeout")

ARTICLE II Purpose

The general purpose of this non-profit corporation shall be as follows: To be the "Association" (as defined in the Condominium Act of the State of Florida, F.S. 744 718 Et Seq., for the operation of PHOENIX TOWERS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC., a Condominium, to be created pursuant to the provisions of the Condominium Act, and as such Association, to operate and administer said Condominium and carry out the functions and duties of said Condominium Association, as set forth in the Declaration of Condominium establishing said Condominium and Exhibits annexed thereto. The Corporation may also be the Association for the operation of additional condominiums which may be created on property adjacent to the above specified Condominium. The Board of Directors shall have the authority in their sole discretion to designate the above Corporation as the Association for such additional condominium(s) and, in such instance(s), the provisions hereafter in these Articles of Incorporation shall be interpreted in such a manner as to include such additional condominium(s).

ARTICLE VI Directors

Section 1. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed and governed by a Board of Directors composed of net less than three (3) nor more than the number specified by the By-Laws, and in the exact number of persons as specified in said Bu-Laws, and in the absence of such determination shall consist of three (3) Directors seven (7) members. Directors need net must be members of the Association, or the spouse or live-in companion of a member, excluding employees of members. The Directors, subsequent to the first Board of Directors, shall be elected at the annual meeting of the membership as provided in the By-Laws. Provisions for such election, and provisions respecting the removal, disqualification and resignation of Directors, and for filling vacancies on the Directorate, shall be established by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII Officers

The names of the Officers who are to serve until the first election of Officers, pursuant to the terms of the Declaration of Condominium and By-Laws, are as follows:

ARTICLE IX VII
By-Laws

The By-Laws of the Corporation shall initially be made and adopted by its first Board of Directors.

Prior to the time any of the property described in Article II hereinabove has been submitted to the Condominium form of ewnership by the filing of the Declaration of Condominium, said first Board of Directors shall have full power and authority to amend, alter or rescind said By Laws by a majority vote.

After any of the property described in Article II has been submitted to Condominium ownership by the filing of the Declaration of Condominium, the By-Laws may be amended, altered, supplemented or modified in accordance with the relevant provisions concerning amendment, alteration, supplementation or modification as may be contained in said By-Laws.

ARTICLE X VIII Amendments

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by any member or director, and shall be adopted in the same manner as is provided for the amendment of the By-Laws, as set forth in Article IX, supra. Said amendment(s) shall be effective when a copy thereof, together with an attached Certificate of its approval by the Membership, sealed with the Corporate seal, signed by the Secretary or an Assistant Secretary, and executed and acknowledged by the President or Vice President, has been filed with the Secretary of the State, and all filing fees paid. Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may also be approved by the membership by written agreement in lieu of a meeting.

ARTICLE XI IX Powers

The Corporation shall have all of the powers set forth in Florida Statutes 617.024 617.0302, all of the powers set forth in the Condominium Act of the state of Florida, and all powers granted to it by the Declaration of Condominium and Exhibits annexed thereto.
