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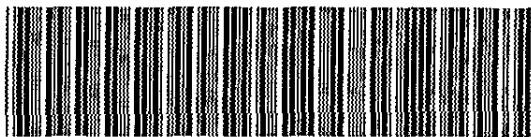

The following provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of TIME2READ, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), filed with the Department of State on April 24, 2000, under document number P00000042088, be and they are hereby, amended as shown below:

1. Article One of the Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is Learning Today, Inc. The principal address of the corporation is: 131 NW 127th Ave., Plantation, FL 33325.
