AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR VOLUSIA COUNTY HISPANIC ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned natural persons of legal age having been duly elected to the Board of Directors to the Volusia County Hispanic Association Inc., a non-profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopt the following amended articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE 1 NAME PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The name of the Corporation is Volusia County Hispanic Association, Inc. and its principal office is located at: 766 Deltona Blvd., Suite A, Deltona, Florida 32725.

ARTICLE 2 REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and registered agent of the Corporation is Zenaida Denizac. The street address of the registered office, which is also the office of the registered agent is: 766 Deltona Blvd., Suite A, Deltona, Florida 32725.

ARTICLE 3 DURATION

The period of duration of this non-profit corporation is: perpetuate.

ARTICLE 4 TYPE OF CORPORATION

The Corporation is a public benefit non-profit corporation organized for a public and charitable purpose which is organized primarily as a secular civic organization.

ARTICLE 5 AUTHORIZATION

The Corporation is organized under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 6 PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized is to promote prosperity and well-being of the Hispanic Community in Volusia County, Florida.

ARTICLE 7 DIRECTORS

The number of Directors constituting the Board of Directors is four (4) and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors are as follows:

ARTICLE 9 ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Directors shall serve for a period of two years and the election of new Directors shall take place at the Annual Meeting of the members to be held on the first Saturday in the month of December of each year. No term limits shall apply.

ARTICLE 10 CORPORATE OFFICERS AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

The general officers of the Corporation shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

- 1. The principal duties of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and to have general supervision of the affairs of the Corporation.
- 2. The principal duties of Vice President shall be to discharge the duties of the President in the event of absence or disability, for any cause, of the President.
- 3. The principal duties of the Secretary shall be to counter-sign all deeds, leases, and conveyances executed by the Corporation, affix the seal of the Corporation to all papers required or directed to be sealed, and to keep a record of the proceedings



of the Board of Directors and to safely and systematically keep all the books, papers, records, and documents belonging to the Corporation, or in any way perpetuating the business of the Corporation, except the books and records incidental to the Treasurer.

4. The principal duties of the Treasurer shall be to keep an account of all monies, credits, and property of the Corporation which come into his or her hands and to keep an accurate record of all monies received and disbursed and of proper vouchers for monies disbursed, and to render all accounts, statements and inventories of monies received and disbursed and of money and property on hand, and generally of allo matters pertaining to the office of Treasurer, as required by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may provide for the appointment of additional officers as they may deem for the best interest of the Corporation. Whenever the Board of Directors may order, any two offices, the duties of which do not conflict, and may be held by one person. The officer shall perform additional or different duties as from time to time are imposed or required by the Board of Directors, or as may be prescribed from time to time by the by-laws.

ARTICLE 12 MEMBERSHIP DUES AND ASSESSMENTS

All members shall be liable for dues and assessments as directed by the Board of Directors. The method by which the dues shall be collected shall be established by the Board of Directors and shall be modified from time to time as the Board deems necessary. Timely payments of dues and assessments is a pre-requisite to membership in the Corporation.

ARTICLE 13 DISTRIBUTION ON DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution of the Corporation, the net assets are to be donated to a non-profit corporation in Volusia County dedicated to promote Hispanic causes.

ARTICLE 14 AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be purported by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors and presented to a quorum of members for their vote. Amendments may be adopted by a vote of two thirds of a quorum of members of the Corporation.
