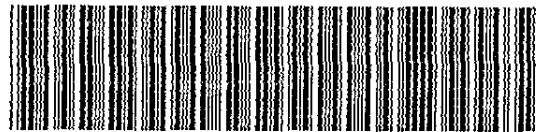

LETTERS PATENT #1071



TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME == GREETING:

Whereas, G. V. Saxon, M. Brash, A. S. Mohr, F. F. Ferris, J. M. Fowles, P. A. Long and J. H. Graves,

on the seventh day of May, A.D., 1908, filed in the office of the Secretary of State a proposed charter of a corporation to be known as PALACHICOLA STATE BANK with a capital of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND ( \$25,000.00 ) dollars, for the purpose of a general banking business, as provided by the laws of the State of Florida;

Charter cancelled pursuant to Institution being closed by Office of Financial Regulation on July 30, 2010 and FDIC named Receiver and bank was subsequently acquired by Centennial Bank, Conway, AR

and have published due notice thereof, and have otherwise complied with the provisions of the laws of this State in such case made, and provided;

Therefore the State of Florida hereby incorporates the above named persons, their associates and successors, into a body politic and corporate, in deed, and in name, and under the said name of PALACHICOLA STATE BANK <sup>NOW</sup> COASTAL COMMUNITY BANK, and grants to them, full power and authority to exercise the powers and privileges of a corporation for the purpose above stated, in accordance with their said charter and the Laws of this State.
