



"Any person may be indempified or reinbursed by the Association for reasonable expenses actually incurred by him in connection with any action, suit, or proceeding to which he is made a party by reason of his being or having been a director, officer, or employee of the Association: Provided, homover, that no person shall be as indemnified or reimbursed in relation to any action, suit, or proceeding in which he shall finally be adjudged to have been negligent in the performance of his duties or to have committed an act or failed to perform a duty for which there is a common-law or a statutory liability: And provided further, that no person shall be so indemnified or reinbursed in relation to any action, suit, or proceeding which has been made the subject of a comprovise settlement, except with the approval of the holders of record of a majorit, of the outstanding shares of this association. The foregoing right of indemnification or reinbursement shall not be exclusive of other rights to which such person may be entitled as a matter of law.
