PLAN OF LIQUIDATION FOR STEWART PONTIAC COMPANY

The undersigned, consisting of all the members of the Board of Directors and all of the shareholders of STEWART PONTIAC COMPANY, a Florida corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation"), do hereby approve and adopt the resolutions hereinafter set forth, and authorize each and all of the acts and transactions described in said resolutions:
