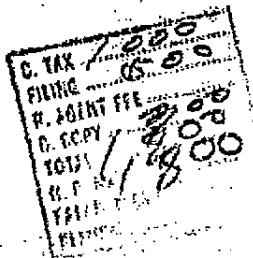

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Laws of the State of Florida, of a corporation for profit and do hereby certify as follows:

-1-  
The name of this corporation shall be:

FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY.

-2-

The general nature or the business or businesses of the corporation, and the objects and purposes proposed to be transacted or carried on by it are as follows:

- a) To transact, sell, lease, service or otherwise dispense to public and private consumers of all types and descriptions, pyrofax gas fuel and/or similar products, machines, appliances and devices of all kinds for the production, servicing, supply and use of light, refrigeration, heat and power, cooking and all similar purposes, and all goods, wares, merchandise, property and substances now used in the production, selling and servicing thereof, or incidental thereto, or that hereafter may be invented, discovered or become known therein, and to manufacture, contract for, service and furnish light, refrigeration, heat and power to other persons, firms or corporations, public or private.
- b) To deal, act and be in the liquefied petroleum gas or similar business, and to generally deal in stoves, refrigerators, cooling equipment, furnaces, radiators, ranges, fixtures, gas appliances and devices of all kinds for heating, lighting, refrigerating, cooking and allied uses by gas, fuel or other agencies and means. To provide facilities for storing and delivering such gas and regulatory equipment, which includes piping and fittings for use with said equipment, and installing, repairing and servicing such equipment. To promote, sell

and service any and all customers for such service and products.  
And generally to transact and do all manner of business relating  
to the above objects and purposes.

c) To buy, or otherwise own, acquire, hold, manage,  
and control real and personal property of every description,  
including its own stock and stock in any other corporations, and  
to sell and convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, or otherwise dispose  
of such property or any part thereof, and to lend money either  
upon or without security, such as is connected with and necessary
