The dissolution of the Corporation was authorized on April 14th, 2000.

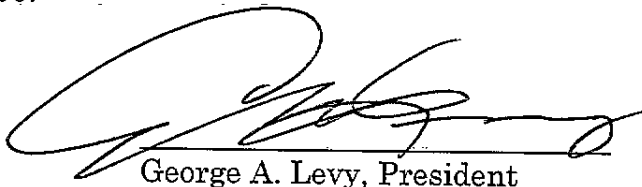
ARTICLE III
