Recently I received a notice from the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations informing me of my corporations delinquency in paying the 2000 Uniform Business Report. This was the first notice of this fee being past due. The original fee was \$150.00 but now there is a \$400.00 fine added to it. I am sure a first notice was sent to me but I never received it as I always had in past years. Of course not being informed of the fee being due is no excuse for not paying it but I take issue with the amount of the fine. If this fee is so critical to warrant such a large fine relative to the original amount, should the original notice be sent in a far more secure fashion than the U.S. Postal Service?

Having a small business, \$400.00 on top of \$150.00 is a very large sum of money but if I have no choice I will have to pay it. I am writing you to ask for help, but if nothing can be done for me, maybe this law could be changed to make the fine a little less for the future.
